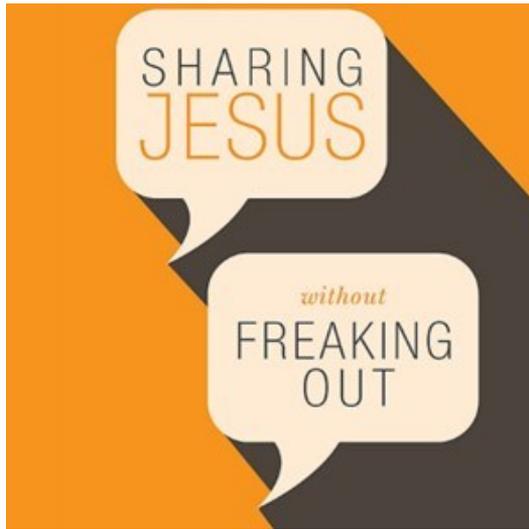


THE EIGHT-WEEK CHALLENGE



Week 8

Principle #8: A Jesus-sharing lifestyle starts with a plan to share Jesus as a part of everyday living.

Scriptures for Meditation

“‘Follow me,’ [Jesus] told them, ‘and I will make you fish for people.’ Immediately [Simon and Andrew] left their nets and followed him.” (Matt 4:19-20)

“You will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come on you, and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth.” (Acts 1:8)

“Jesus came near and said to them, ‘All authority has been given to me in heaven and on earth. Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe everything I have commanded you. And remember, I am with you always, to the end of the age.’” (Matt 28:18-20)

Questions for Reflection and Application

1. In what ways is your life gospel-focused?

2. What do you understand about your specific giftedness, calling, and opportunities? What has God made you good at? What are you passionate about? What unique opportunities has God given you (think: people, places, situations)?
3. Write out some ways you can share Jesus out of the sweet spot of your life.
4. Consider the steps for living an evangelistic life. Which of these are most challenging for you?
5. What plans do you have for developing an evangelistic lifestyle? Are you ready to commit to the life we have called you to? Why or why not?
6. Review your notes from the past eight weeks. What has God shown you—people, principles, opportunities—that you are most thankful for? What have you made part of your life that you hope you never forget?
7. How can you make evangelism part of your family culture?
8. Write one or two paragraphs describing your plan for sharing Christ regularly.
9. *Who's Your One?* How has God used you to influence *your one* for Christ? What are the next steps you believe you need to take?

Topics for Prayer

1. For God to prepare you and use you in the lives of others.
2. For God to anchor the principles of this book in your mind so that you will not forget all that he has taught you.
3. For God to continue to help you grow as a witness, giving you eyes to see opportunities and the boldness to step out in faith—to share Jesus without freaking out.

God, I know you love people. Give me an opportunity today to help someone see your love for them and hear how they can enjoy your work in Jesus Christ. Give me the boldness to talk with them about Jesus.
